The Sunset Symphony Orchestra

The SUNSET SYMPHONY was formed in 1975 to provide challenge, experience and enrichment of the cultural interest of musically talented students within the Clark County School District. The program has truly come a long way. Over the years, Sunset has consistently won superior and excellent ratings at local and regional festivals in the West, including the Mountain States Musical Festival at Arizona State University, and numerous festivals held in Clark County. The American String Teachers Association recognizes this as a model program.

Placement and section seating in the orchestra are by audition and outstanding students are accepted from primary school through high school. An average of 30 Sunset students annually are accepted by audition into the Nevada All State Orchestra, which is comprised of the highest calibre musicians from high schools in the State of Nevada. Many students have gone on to highly recognized colleges, universities and music conservatories through scholarships, and into professional and teaching careers. More than ten students who graduated in June 1985 were awarded full music scholarships to various colleges.

At the close of last year's season, the SUNSET SYMPHONY conductor, musicians, parents and loyal supporters were indeed proud of the bronze medal awarded to the symphony for its performance at the Fiesta Musicale in Mexico. Many hours of hard work paid off by this achievement of international recognition.
